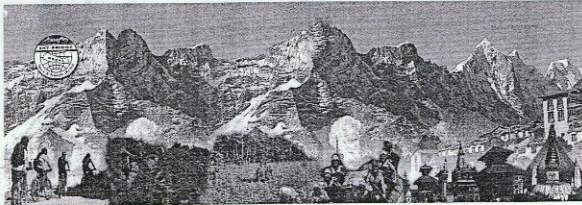

Board of Directors : all the works relating to tours and transport. He looks after itineraries and it's cost for all the companies made for the tour operators of the company. It is the supreme body which gives the final decisions of all the activities of the company. Generally at least once a year there will be Board of Director's Meeting to review the function of the company relating to financial situation, planning of the companies work and assessment of the activities performed by the company. But on exceptional cases, at the request of the Managing Director the Board of Directors will meet and make emergency decisions. The Board of Directors will nominate the Managing Director of the company.

Managing Director : He is the Chief Executive of the company. He makes the immediate decisions in the company on matters of financial dealings, in the execution of works performed by the executives by the company and assessment of the staff's work, and other related works of the company. He is accountable to the Board of Directors of his performances.

Director Marketing and Promotion : He is the head of the department for the marketing and promotion sector. He will use his discretionary power for the execution office duty relating to expenses instant decisions and other things that comes while discharging his duty. Besides, he will supervise all correspondence relating to tours, travels and accounts. He is accountable to the Managing Director of his performances.

Director sales and General Administration :

He looks after the area of sales concerning travel, tour and other related services. He is the credit controller of the sales deal. He is accountable to the Managing Director of his performances.

Director Tours and Transport :

He is responsible for all the works relating to tours and transport. He looks after itineraries and its costing for all the enquiries made by the tour operators and forwards them the same. As per the requirement he will make foreign visit on business promotion. He supervises the arrangements of all the transports as per the requirements of the clients. He is accountable to the Managing Director of his performances.

Since above mentioned three Directors having same nature of job on business promotion, they will consult each other on the major issues on business deal and on matters of maximum benefits of the company.

Director Finance :

He is the head of the finance department and looks after the works of financial matters of all departments. Description on Places of Interest

Kathmandu Durbar Square :

It was to be overwhelmed by the seemingly uncountable monuments in the Kathmandu Durbar Square. In this Durbar Square there are the old palace buildings, temple of living goddess (Kumari Ghar), the statue of Dreadful aspect of Shiva – Kal Bhairab, Jagannath temple with erotic carving and Kasthmandap – the rest house, from which the Kathmandu valley got its name. Most of the temples and palace are in Pagoda architecture. The whole Palace Square is listed in World Heritage sites.

Swayambhunath Stupa :

It is one of the world's glorious Buddhist Stupa. It is said to be 2,000 years old. It is situated on a hillock about 77 M above the level of the Kathmandu Valley and it provides an excellent view of the whole Kathmandu valley.

Pashupatinath Temple :

This is Shiva shrine and all Shivas from all over the world come to pay homage to this shrine one in their life time. Since Lord Shiva being the god of destruction, we have the cremation platforms beside this temple to cremate the death bodies of Hindus and to perform the last rites.

Bouddhanath Stupa :

Bouddhanath is among the largest stupas in South Asia - is the 5th century Buddhist shrine. Most of the Monastries of the surroundings belong to Tibetan Buddhist schools. It has become the focal point of Tibetan Buddhism in Nepal.

Budhanilkantha :

It is seven K.M north east of Kathmandu. It is a lying colossal Vishnu statue in black stone. According to the stone inscription, It was carved in the 7th century.

Kirtipur :

Kirtipur city – it is 7 K.M south west of Kathmandu, situated on a hill . It is an ancient city and still preserve the ancient culture and tradition by the local people of this city – although it is very near to modern Kathmandu city.

Dakshinkali :

It is situated 22 K.M south west of Kathmandu. This temple is dedicated to Goddess Kali. Animal sacrifices (Male only) are made on every Tuesdays and Saturdays except 15 July to 15 August.

Patan :

The ancient city is situated on the southern bank of the river Bagamati and is about five kms southeast of Kathmandu. The city is full of Buddhist monuments and Hindu temples with fine bronze gateways, guardian deities and wonderful carvings. Noted for its craftsmen and metal workers, it is known as the city of artists. Lalitpur, "the city of beauty," is another name of Patan.

Bungamati & Khokana :

Bungamati is 4 K.M west of Patan. In Bungamati there is a temple of Rato Machendranath- God of rain. A month long festival of Rato Machhindranath is held every year before the monsoon starts. Next to Bungamati is Khokana village. Both villages are in habitat by Newari people and preserves the traditional culture even today. This Khokana village is famous for producing mustard oil still processing in a Traditional way.

Bhaktapur :

Bhaktapur means "the city of devotees" in the Sanskrit language. It is also known as Bhadgaon.. The palace complex in the middle of the city portrays the prosperity of the Malla years and the details at which the craftspeople then worked. The Palace of Fifty-five Windows stands in the square and it was home to many kings of Bhaktapur. The monuments of Bhaktapur are the big bell, the Golden Gate, the five-tiered temple of Nyatapola, the Bhairab Temple and The Dattatreya Square with its wood carving and metal work museums. Surrounded by beautiful farming area.

Changunarayan Temple :

It is situated on a hillock in the Bhaktapur district. It is the 5th century temple dedicated to lord Vishnu. In the complex of this temple, there are some of the statue which bear exceptional sculpture . Among the four holy Vishnu temples in the valley, one of them is Changunarayan.

Tansen :

Dhulikhel :

Dhulikhel is situated 30 K.M. North East of Kathmandu on the way to Tibet boarder. There is the traditional Newari village and town. One can have beautiful view of the central and eastern Himalayan range from the rooms of most of the hotels.

Panauti :

It is situated 30 K.M north east Kathmandu. There are three tantric Hindu temples on the bank of two river Rosi and Indrati. At the confluence of the river once a year religious festival is being held. It is a medieval Newari city and still preserves the traditional way of life.

Namobuddha Stupa :

It is situated on the ridge of a hill approximate 3 hrs walk from Dhulikhel or 2 hours walk from Panauti. It is one of the holiest Stupas for the majority Buddhist people of Nepal.

Gorkha :

Gorkha is situated at the elevation of 1600 M and 145 K.M South / West of Kathmandu . It is a hill bazaar and the ancestral home of the Shah dynasty which rules Nepal Today. The palace also boasts beautiful architecture. The word Gorkha used in British and Indian army is derived from this place.

Bandipur :

Bandipur village is in between Gorkha and Pokhara. It is still untouched area from the westners. You will have good view of Himalaya and the valley.

Pokhara :

Pokhara is situated 200km South- West of Kathmandu at the altitude of 850m. Pokhara is center of adventure and a place of natural beauty. An enchanting city nestled in a tranquil valley. It is starting point of Nepal's most popular trekking .It is known as van ice of Asia.

Tansen :

Optional activities

Tansen is situated 123 km Southwest of Pokhara at the altitude of 1600m. From there Dhaulagiri and Annapurna range can be seen very clearly and at the close range. Tansen town is typical and traditional Newari city and Model of ancient Kathmandu.

Bardia National Park :

This National Park is situated in the terai and almost at the central point of Nepal, which has an area of 986sq km. The park is home of elusive Royal Bengal Tiger, other wild animals and about 400 species of birds.

Royal Chitwan National Park :

This National park is situated in inner terai of Nepal which has an area of 936sq km. It is home for one horned Asian Rhino, Royal Bengal Tiger, rare and common wild animals, more than 500 migratory and residential birds.

Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve :

Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve is situated in the eastern part of Nepal with an area of 175 sq km. It is famous for aqua birds and wild buffalos.

Mountain Biking :

Mountain biking is a fun way to see rural Nepal. The riders are given maps and welcomed a Nepalese people at their homes. In the past, mountain biking was only for the rich and now it has become a popular sport for many people. Visa formalities

Everest flight :

It is one hour flight from Katmandu domestic airport.

The flight first goes to the central Himalaya and turns east and goes up to Kanchenjunga and the people sitting to the left side of the aircraft will see the Himalayan range from the window while the people sitting on the right side of the aircraft will be invited to the cockpit to see the Himalayan ranges and then when the aircraft turns back to the same route and the people sitting on the right side will see the Himalayas from the window while people sitting on the left side of the aircraft will go to the cockpit and see the Himalayan view. The seat arrangements are one seat one window.

White water Rafting :

White water rafting means cruising down a rushing river in an inflatable rubber raft or white water kayak over crashing waves and swirling rapids for the excitement of a lifetime. Nepal has earned a reputation as one of the best destinations in the world for white water rafting. Nepal's thundering waters, coming from the glaciers of the mighty Himalaya, provide unmatched thrills for rafting and immersing oneself in the landscape.

Rivers are graded on a scale of one to six. The popular rivers for rafting are Trisuli, Kali Gandaki,

The Bhoti Kosi, Maryshayngdi, Karnali River.

Mountain Biking :

Mountain biking is a fast way to see rural Nepal. The villages are quaint and you will see the Nepalese people as they are. You can ride through rice fields, bike to the Terai town or test your mountain biking skills by traveling to Mount Mera with your bike. The mountain biking possibilities and streets are "endless" in Nepal. Many mountain mud tracks have created a paradise for the action biker.

Kayaking :

Kayaking is also done in the rivers of Nepal.

Canyoning :

Canyoning is also available in Nepal but it is seasonal from March to May and in October and November.

Bungee Jumping :

It is at the height of 160 m from the Bhoti-koshi river. It is also seasonal from March to May and September to November.

Paragliding :

Paragliding and Ultra-light flights are done in the Pokhara valley.

Visa formalities

Nepal visa :

It can be had in once respective country in Nepal Embassy or Nepal consulate offices. It can also be obtain on arrival at Kathmandu airport or at eight entry points of Nepal for the surface travelers. You can have single, double or multiple entry visa for Nepal.

Indian visa :

One should obtain this visa in one's country itself in the Indian embassies.
For Sikkim visit one has to apply interline Permit along with Indian visa application.

Tibet visa :

One has to forward us the passport details such as full name, date of birth, sex, profession, passport no, date of issue and expiry along with the package one has booked with us about a month before one's arrival in Kathmandu by fax or by email. The same will be forwarded to the Tibet authority for the sanction of visa and it will forward visa approval to the Chinese Embassy of Kathmandu with intimation to us. On one's arrival in Kathmandu, it takes one week for stamping the visa in the Passport for emergency we charge \$40 extra if it is required in one day. The visa days are Monday, Wednesday and Friday only. On other days they will not entertain the request.

Bhutan visa :

Along with the package one has booked, the passport details as above should be forwarded to us one month before the arrival in Kathmandu. The same will be forwarded to Bhutan authority and the visa approval forwarded to us by fax and the original visa approval letter has to come in Kathmandu Druk Air office for the issuing of air tickets. Ticket and the original visa letter will be handed over to the client on arrival at Kathmandu airport and on arrival at Paro Airport, on presentation of Original Visa Letter, the Bhutan Immigration will stamp visa on payment of \$ 20.00 Per Person.
